**TRAINING**

- Tuesday night training seasons will resume in early June.

**VOLUNTEER STAFF**

- Our volunteer staff will be transitioning to summer operations later this month

**APPARATUS / EQUIPMENT**

- Engine 9 and Brush 91 will be out of service pending repairs. Engine 9 has braking issues and Brush 91 has parking brake issues that have to be corrected before they will be in service this season. Brush 9, Brush 92 are in service. Fire Boat 9 will be in service by the end of May.

**LOCAL AGENCIES / AGREEMENTS**

- All agreements are in place.
- The El Dorado County Board of Supervisors instructed County Officials to draft an Agreement to Provide Funding for Fire Protection and Emergency Medical Services and Related Equipment. This agreement would be for one year 2010-2011 in the amount of \$38,690.
- The El Dorado County Board of Supervisors on a vote of 3 to 2, voted not to fund the agreement that was presented to the district by the county.
- We are continuing our efforts to have the funding matter brought back before the Board of Supervisors.

**PROJECTS AND PREVENTION**

- The Fuel reduction project that is currently in place will continue as weather permits.

- **It appears that funding for our Cal Fire Engine that responds from LVFD station #5 will be funded this year. Chief Huggins advised it may be the middle of June before Engine 2758 will be staffed.**
- **Once again this year we will be conducting in conjunction with Cal Fire, Defensible Space Inspection. If you have any questions concerning the defensible space inspection provided by the Fallen Leaf Fire Department or Cal Fire please contact the Fire Department. Please practice Fire Safety.**
- **Sandra Stauffer and Patty Working have been working on preparation for the July 30<sup>th</sup> Wine Tasting Fund Raiser for the Fire Department. We will have a silent auction this year. Any donations may be coordinated through Patty Working. Please put this date on your calendar for another great event this summer**
- **We have planned a Fire Extinguisher inspection program this summer. We have two tentative dates. The inspection date will be on the Memorial Day weekend and August 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>. This would allow anyone who needs to have their Fire Extinguisher inspected to drop them off at the Fire Station and we will schedule with the service provider a time for the inspection or any needed service for a scheduled fee. As always every cabin needs several working fire extinguisher for the owners use. Please make sure your extinguisher is in good working order and has a current inspection.**
- **The Fire Department members will be conducting training on Tuesday nights throughout the summer. If community members would like to “Feed The Firefighters” on Tuesday nights, please contact the Fire Station after Mid May and check for available dates.
