## **Aquatic Invasive Species Boat Wash Process at Fallen Leaf Lake**

### **Routine (hot water wash with 140 degree + water)**

Fallen Leaf Marina will wash, flush and inspect every boat/trailer prior to launching at Fallen Leaf Marina. An individual document (Tahoe Resource Conservation District "TRCD" provided) for each boat will be filled out by the inspector (Fallen Leaf Landing) and kept in a Boat Wash binder on site at the marina office. Tahoe Regional Planning Agency "TRPA" and TRCD will periodically stop by and check these documents to verify Fallen Leaf Lake compliance.

Upon request of the boat operator, boats leaving Fallen Leaf will have a blue plastic seal attached to the boat and trailer at the bow eye

### **Boats Returning to Fallen Leaf with an Intact Fallen Leaf Seal (no evidence of tampering)**

Will require a brief re-inspection however a wash may be required at the discretion of the inspector.

### **Identification of a Contaminated Boat**

The boat operator will not be allowed to launch the boat at Fallen Leaf Lake. They will be advised of the contamination and instructed to take the boat to an approved cleaning station (Tahoe Keys). They will also need to call ahead to confirm the wash station is open.

The Fallen Leaf ramp operator will gather as much identifying information about the operator, boat, trailer, and tow vehicle as possible

The Fallen Leaf ramp operator will call 1-888-TAHOANS immediately, report the contaminated boat, and provide operator, boat, trailer, and tow vehicle identifying formation on the TRCD Hot Line.

A log of the incident including all information gathered will be inserted into the Boat Wash binder being kept by Fallen Leaf Landing.

## **Boats Requiring Extensive Washing or Decontamination Beyond Fallen Leaf Abilities**

Boat operator will be referred to TRCD's washing station at Tahoe Keys Marina (see above)

Upon returning to Fallen Leaf following an inspection and cleaning / decontamination at Tahoe Keys Marina, the boat will be allowed to launch without further inspection or washing **IF**

The boat operator has a date/time stamped receipt from TRCD's washing station within **2 hours** of the current time/date indicating the boat was inspected, washed, flushed, and certified free of AIS **and** the boat has an intact (no signs of tampering) TRCD seal connecting the boat to the trailer

*The boat operator will still need to pay Fallen Leaf launch fees*

## **Boats Arriving at Fallen Leaf With an Intact Seal from Another Lake**

All boats arriving at Fallen Leaf with a seal, intact or otherwise, will be required to undergo washing, flushing, and inspection at Fallen Leaf
